MEMORANDUM OF ASSOCIATION.

1. Name. The Name of the Society shall be CHEMBUR COLONY YUVAK MANDAL.
2. Aims & Objects. The AIMS & OBJECTS of the MANDAL shall be:-
  - (a) To work for the Literary advancement of the people by starting and maintaining libraries reading rooms, Educational and Cultural Publications and issue Periodicals.
  - (b) To work for the educational advancement of the students by starting Book-Bank study rooms etc. etc.
  - (c) To render medical aid to the poor on Charitable basis.
  - (d) To start manage take over and maintain Educational institution.
  - (e) To work for the moral, intellectual and physical advancement of the youth.
  - (f) To give loan with or without interest and or guarantee to trusts registered under Bombay Public Trust Act, 1950.
  - (g) To help deserving students by giving Free-Ships, Scholar-Ship or other financial help as grant or loan with or without interest.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The membership of the Chembur Colony Yuvak Mandal shall remain open to all residents of Chembur, who subscribe without reservation to the Aims & Objects of the Mandal and have attained the age of 15 years at the time of applying. However, the restrictions regarding age and residence may be waived by the Managing Committee in any particular case.
2. There shall be three classes of membership viz:
  - i) Patron    ii) Life member & iii) Honorary member.
    - i) Patron : Any person who has donated Rs.5000/- or more to the Mandal and is invited by the Managing Committee to become a patron of the Mandal.
    - ii) Life Member: Any person who desires to become a Life Member, shall make an application in writing addressed to the President of the Mandal. The application must be supported by atleast two life members and accompanied by a fees of Rs.500/-. Every such member shall become Life Member of the Mandal after the Managing Committee approves his application. The Managing Committee may however reject any application without assigning any reason. In the event, if an application is rejected or if the application is withdrawn before being approved, the membership fees shall be refunded in full.
    - iii) All the ordinary members of the Mandal, on the day on which this announcement becomes effective shall automatically become Life Members.
    - iii) Honorary Members: The Managing Committee may by passing a resolution to that effect, invite any eminent person or persons interested in the activities of the Mandal to become Honorary Member. On accepting such invitation, such person shall become Honorary Member. The term of that Honorary Member shall be 3 years from the date of acceptance of invitation.

Provided that the number of Honorary Members at any time shall not exceed 20.
3. A member wishing to resign may do so by making an application in writing addressed to the Secretary of the Mandal, which he shall place before the Managing Committee for disposal.
4. A member shall be liable to expelled, for any act of Commission or Commissions which, in the opinion of the Managing Committee is improper. The Managing Committee may expell the member concerned by a resolution after giving the member an opportunity to explain his conduct. The decision of the Managing Committee shall be final.
5. Any person ceasing to be a member for any reason whatsoever shall cease to have any wight in the property of the Mandal as such member.

The following shall be the Office bearers of the Mandal, who will be elected by the members ~~every~~ after every three years. The election may be held in May for the subsequent year.

- i) President
- ii) Chairman
- iii) Vice-Chairman
- iv) Secretary
- v) Jt Secretary
- vi) Treasurer
- vii) 4 members of the Managing Committee.

The President may be elected amongst the Patrons or the members. All the other office bearers must be elected from amongst the members only.

- 7. The Managing Committee shall be authorised to coop two more members if it so chooses.
- 8. A day clear notice shall be necessary for a General Body Meeting and 2 days clear notice for a Managing Committee Meeting. Notice posted on Notice Board in Mandal Premises shall be considered as sufficient notice.
- 9. The vacancies in the Managing Committee shall be filled by the Managing Committee for the rest of the term.
- 10. The Secretary shall call a General Body Meeting within fourteen days if a requisition for the same is made in writing by one third of the members of the Mandal.
- 11. The quorum of the Managing Committee shall be one third of its strength and that of General Body Meeting, one third of its strength or 10 which ever is lower. No quorum is however necessary for an adjourned meeting though fresh notice must be given.
- 12. The Secretary shall have the power to spend Rs.25/- during the calander month for unbudgeted items. All other expenses must be sanctioned by the Managing Committee.
- 13. The account must be audited at the end of every year by an auditor appointed by Managing Committee every year.
- 14. The Managing Committee shall be authorised to make any bye-laws for the smooth and efficient management of the Mandal.
- 15. The Rules and Regulations may be amended, added to or altered by the General Body on the recommendation of the Managing Committee.
